PUBLIC NOTICE

APPLICATION TO MODIFY SERVICE AREA RUNAWAY BAY WATER COMPANY LIMITED

The Office of Utilities Regulation (OUR) advises that Runaway Bay Water Company Limited with registered office at 12 Ocean Boulevard, Kingston and the holder of Water Supply and Sewerage Service Licences, has applied for a modification to its service area in the parish of St. Catherine. This Notice is issued pursuant to the Office of Utilities Regulation Act.

The previous description of the Location of Service is as follows:

Starting at the intersection of Mandela Highway and the Caymanas Estate parochial road and then proceeding in an easterly direction along the northern boundary of the Mandela Highway to Ferry; then, in a generally north-easterly direction along the property boundaries of the Ferry Police Station, IGL, Tile City and Hydel Group of Schools to the western boundary of the Fresh River; then, in a generally northerly direction along the western boundary of the Fresh River to where it intersects with the southern boundary of Moses Lake; then, in a generally westerly direction along the southern boundary of Moses Lake to intersect with the Caymanas Estate parochial road (leading to Caymanas Bay); then, continuing in a generally westerly direction to incorporate sections of the Caymanas Estate commonly called Caymanas Highlands and Airstrip lands which forms the western boundary; then, going in a generally southerly direction along the eastern extent of the Windsor Heights community to intersect with the Mandela Highway; then in a generally easterly direction back to the starting point.

Runaway Bay Water Company Limited's application is for the amendment of the Location of Service to read, the area as described in the following Designation Order:
