Carrier Licence (pursuant to section 13)

The Minister pursuant to section 13 of the Telecommunications Act hereby grants a carrier licence to **Jamus Communications Limited** of **47D Old Hope Road**, **Kingston 5**, subject to the terms and conditions specified in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Terms and Conditions of Licence

Grant of Rights

- 1. The licensee is licensed to own or operate, in accordance with the terms of this licence, the following facilities:
 - a) Switches, ducts, poles, towers, point to point radio systems, cables to send and receive domestic traffic.
 - b) Satellite antenna systems, sub-marine cable systems, cable landing stations, international leased lines, switches to send and receive international traffic

Commencement, Duration and Renewal of Licence

- 2. This licence shall take effect on January 18, 2010 and shall expire on the January 17, 2025.
- 3. This licence shall be renewable pursuant to section 15 of the Telecommunications Act.

<u>Assignment or Transfer of Licence</u>

4. This licence and any right granted hereunder shall not be assigned or otherwise transferred except in accordance with the Telecommunications Act.

General

- 5. Any notice or other document required or authorized to be served upon the licensee may be served at the licensee's address, or where the licensee is a company, the address of its registered office.
- 6. This licence, and the terms and conditions hereof, shall constitute the entire licence and supersede any prior licenses, permits or undertakings.
- 7. The Licensee shall ensure that:
 - a) It complies with the provisions of the Telecommunications Act, and all rules and regulations made pursuant to the Act, and to the Laws of Jamaica.
 - b) no legal impediment exists which would disqualify the Licensee from continuing to hold the Licence and that the Licensee satisfies all other legal requirements to hold the Licence;
 - c) it has the technical qualifications to fully perform the obligations attaching to the Licence
 - d) it satisfies any and all financial requirements, as imposed by the Minister, the Office of Utilities Regulation and the Spectrum Management Authority, to provide the services to the public associated with this licence; and
 - e) it does not operate a facility designated in this Licence beyond the period of this licence or in any manner other than that authorized by this licence.

Revocation or Suspension of Licence

8. Any contravention of the above terms and conditions may result in the suspension or revocation of this licence pursuant to the provisions of the Telecommunications Act.
