REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL CONSULT ON AND DEVELOP LONG RUN INCREMENTAL COST (LRIC) MODEL

The Office of Utilities Regulation (OUR) invites proposals from suitably qualified and experienced firms to consult on and develop a Long Run incremental Cost Model to determine the rate to be charged for mobile interconnection.

SCOPE OF WORK

- Undertake the required industry discussion and analysis to develop an appreciation
 of the types of networks that currently exist, their topology, the dispersion of the
 population being served and the accounting procedures in use;
- Undertake consultations with interested stakeholders on the principles, methodology, and guidelines which will influence the LRIC modeling process;
- Identify and assess all possible options for the development of the LRIC model (bottom-up, top-down, or hybrid) and recommend the most appropriate formulation given the local context;
- Draft consultation document;
- Evaluate the comments received on the consultation document and prepare a response and a final document;
- Develop the LRIC model along with input data to calculate costs of interconnection;
 and
- Train selected OUR staff members on how to use the LRIC model.

ELIGIBILITY TO TENDER

Interested local firms must submit a copy of a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) with their proposal. Interested foreign firms, while not required to be in possession of the TCC at the time of proposal submission, must provide a valid TCC at the time of contract signing. The procurement is open to consultants of all nationalities.

Failure to adhere to these eligibility requirements will result in the disqualification of the bld.
