SENIOR REGULATORY ANALYST

CORE FUNCTIONS: Under the general direction of the Manager, Regulation and Policy – Electricity, Water & Sewerage, the incumbent is responsible to, inter alia:

- ◆ Analyze, monitor and evaluate the financial, economic and operational performance of the regulated utilities and assess whether they are meeting the economic and operating conditions as set out in their licences, relevant legislation and decisions of the Office;
- ◆ Assist in the development and monitoring of utility tariffs;
- ◆ Monitor and conduct Efficiency Impact Assessments on the regulated utilities;
- ◆ Monitor and analyze key economic indicators and their impact on the utility sectors;
- ◆ Assist in the establishment and maintenance of the relevant database for the monitoring of the utility sectors;
- ◆ Assist in the enforcement of regulations, licences condition, directives and decisions of the Office;
- ◆ Make presentations on the OUR's position to various interest groups.
