PUBLIC NOTICE

TELECOMMUNICATIONS CARRIERS AND PROVIDERS OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

The Office of Utilities Regulation (OUR) **HEREBY REMINDS THE PUBLIC** that section 9 of the Telecommunications Act (“Telecoms Act”) expressly forbids the ownership or operation of a telecommunications facility and/or the provision of telecommunications services to the public without a valid Telecommunications Licence issued by the Minister with portfolio responsibility.

The **PUBLIC IS HEREBY NOTIFIED** that, pursuant to its powers under the Telecoms Act, the OUR will take enforcement action against any person found to be operating in breach of the provisions of the said Act.

The relevant application forms for the processing of new licences and for renewal of licences may be downloaded from the OUR’s website at www.our.org.jm, or may be obtained from the OUR’s office at the PCJ Resource Centre, 3rd Floor, 36 Trafalgar Road, Kingston 10. Completed application forms for new licences and for renewal of expired/expiring licences should be submitted to the OUR’s office.

The names of companies currently licensed to provide telecommunications services are listed on the OUR’s website.
