REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL CONSUMER SURVEY

The Office of Utilities Regulation (OUR) invites bids to conduct an OUR Consumer Survey - **The Regulator, Utility Services and You**. The survey will seek to obtain critical information on whether consumers have noticed improvements in the provision of utility services and their views on the effectiveness of the OUR.

ELIGIBILITY

Interested local firms are required to submit a copy of a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) with their proposal. Interested foreign firms, while not required to be in possession of the TCC at the time of proposal submission, must provide a valid TCC at the time of contract signing. The procurement is open to consultants of all nationalities.

Failure to adhere to these eligibility requirements will result in the disqualification of the bid.
