REGULATORY ANALYST

CORE FUNCTIONS: The successful applicant will become a member of the Regulation, Policy, Monitoring and Enforcement Department and will, inter alia:

- ◆ Conduct financial and economic analysis of projects and companies to inform regulatory decisions;
- ◆ Conduct financial and economic analysis of markets (historical, current and projected) to inform regulatory decisions;
- ◆ Plan, manage and execute a range of analytical tasks relevant to regulatory decisions and initiatives;
- ◆ Independently gather and analyse financial information and operating statistics and maintain regulatory databases;
- ◆ Monitor and report on critical utility sector variables and indices;
- ◆ Perform statistical analysis and hypothesis testing;
- ◆ Engage in model building and alternative scenarios testing;
- ◆ Provide technical policy analysis and advice on regulatory and legislative issues;
- ◆ Perform tariff analysis to determine revenue effect, customer impact, etc.;
- ◆ Undertake extensive report writing and perform other relevant functions which may be assigned from time to time.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS & KEY COMPETENCIES:

- ◆ Postgraduate degree in Finance or Economics from a recognized tertiary institution. Candidates who have a first degree in accounting will be at a distinct advantage;
- ◆ At least three (3) years work experience in any position which incorporates all or most of the core functions detailed above;
- ◆ Proficiency in the use of contemporary modeling and analytical software and Microsoft Office Suite applications;
