OUR Opens Bids for Proposals for Generation Capacity

(KINGSTON, Jamaica, August 8, 2013): The Office of Utilities Regulation (OUR) has received five (5) final proposals from four (4) entities for the supply of base-load generating capacity to the national grid.

The opening of the proposals took place at the OUR on August 8, 2013 shortly after the submission deadline at 3:00 pm.
