Reference is made to your letter dated 17 September 2019; I would like to indicate that our interpretation was that the initial tariff in section 3 of the License was satisfied by the information we provided in section B. 3 on the application form. We were of the opinion that these proposed rates were being approved simultaneously with the granting of our licenses. We only learnt by way of your letter that this was not so, as we have sought clarification from your office on the matter.

We hereby confirm that water and sewage charges at rates set out in our applications have been applied to the residents of Richmond since the granting of the Licenses (2013). Given this, we would like to apply for approval of the existing rates as an interim rate (see table below), while we gather all the information required for us to apply for new tariffs consistent with our Licenses and cost of operations.

The Richmond environmental services currently serve eight hundred and sixteen residential customers.
