# TELECOMMUNICATIONS INDUSTRY NOTIFICATION RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF FIXED TERMINATION RATES

**2017 NOVEMBER 6**

Reference is made to the Office of Utilities Regulation (“OUR”) decisions regarding the approval and implementation of fixed termination rates in the telecommunications industry as set out in the documents listed below, and to the Telecommunications Industry Notifications regarding the captioned of 2017 September 28 and October 6:

On 2017 October 31 the Supreme Court denied the application of Cable & Wireless Jamaica Limited (“C&WJ”) as set out in its Notice of Application for Court Orders – Claim No. HCV2017/03122 - dated 2017 September 28 in which it sought, *inter alia*, leave to apply for judicial review of the OUR’s Reconsideration Decision, and an interim injunction restraining the implementation of the said decision pending the outcome of the application for judicial review.

This is to notify the industry that **2017 December 1** is now the new date for implementation of the first step in the glide path defined in the Determination Notice.
