INVITATION TO COMMENT ON CONSULTATION DOCUMENT REVIEW OF THE NUMBER PORTABILITY FRAMEWORK - PHASE ONE

The Office of Utilities Regulation (OUR) is inviting members of the public to make comments on proposals to modify the guidelines for porting telephone numbers when switching to another telecoms service provider.

Number portability covers both fixed and mobile networks. The OUR has regulatory oversight of the number portability administration.

The OUR has issued a Consultation document titled, **Review of the Number Portability Framework - Phase One**, to assess the existing Industry Number Portability Guidelines (INPG). The INPG provides the guiding principles to manage the processes and activities required when a number is being ported.

The review of the INPG is the first of a three-phase process to review the number portability framework.
