What is a Digital Library

A digital collection, also known as a <u>digital</u> <u>library</u>, is any collection of items that has been digitally preserved and is accessible on the internet or through software. A digital library may contain newspapers, books, journals, images, audio, and video.

- watch a movie on Netflix;
- read a magazine on Google Books;
- research *History* using the Library of Congress' website; or
- rediscover a favorite classic book on Project Gutenberg?
