

Frequently Asked Questions

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When and where will the 20th Annual Conference of the Organisation of Caribbean Utility Regulators take place?

The conference will be held October 26-29, 2025, at the Jewel Grande Resort & Spa in Montego Bay, Jamaica. The hotel is approximately 15 minutes from Sangster International Airport. Who can attend the conference?

This event will bring together utility regulators, attorneys-at-law, engineers and other professionals, policymakers, academics, and service providers from across the Caribbean and North America.

Do I need to register in advance?

What is included in my registration fee?

Your registration fee includes access to all sessions, networking events, conference materials, meals, and any applicable field trips. Daily registration rates only cover events held on **that** day.

What is the cost to stay at the host hotel?
