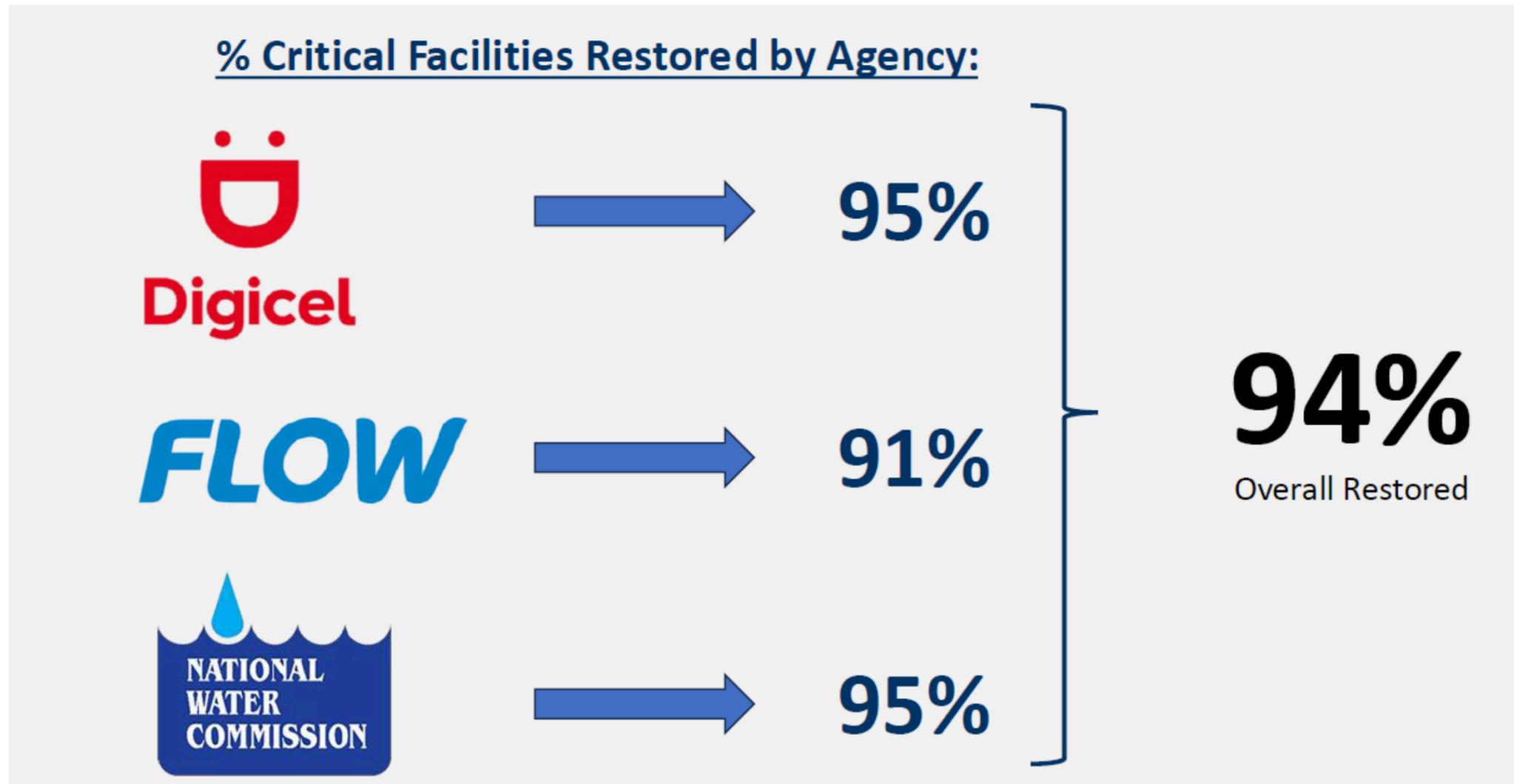

RESTORATION & SYSTEM STATUS



Restoration of critical facilities that depend on JPS power continues to advance.

- **Digicel:** JPS has reported 95 percent of its powered critical sites restored.
- **FLOW:** 91 percent restored.
- **NWC:** 95 percent restored.

Overall, JPS has reported that 94 percent of all JPS-powered critical facilities have been restored islandwide.
