Since the passage of Hurricane Melissa, JPS reports that approximately 80 percent of customers across the island now have service.





RESTORATION STATUS

JPS restoration highlights over the last twenty four hours include:

- In St Ann, the corridor from Runaway Bay to Orange Valley was energised.
- In Manchester, FLOW and Digicel cell sites in Walderston were restored.
- In St Elizabeth, the Yardley Chase community regained service.
- In Clarendon, McNie Primary School was restored.

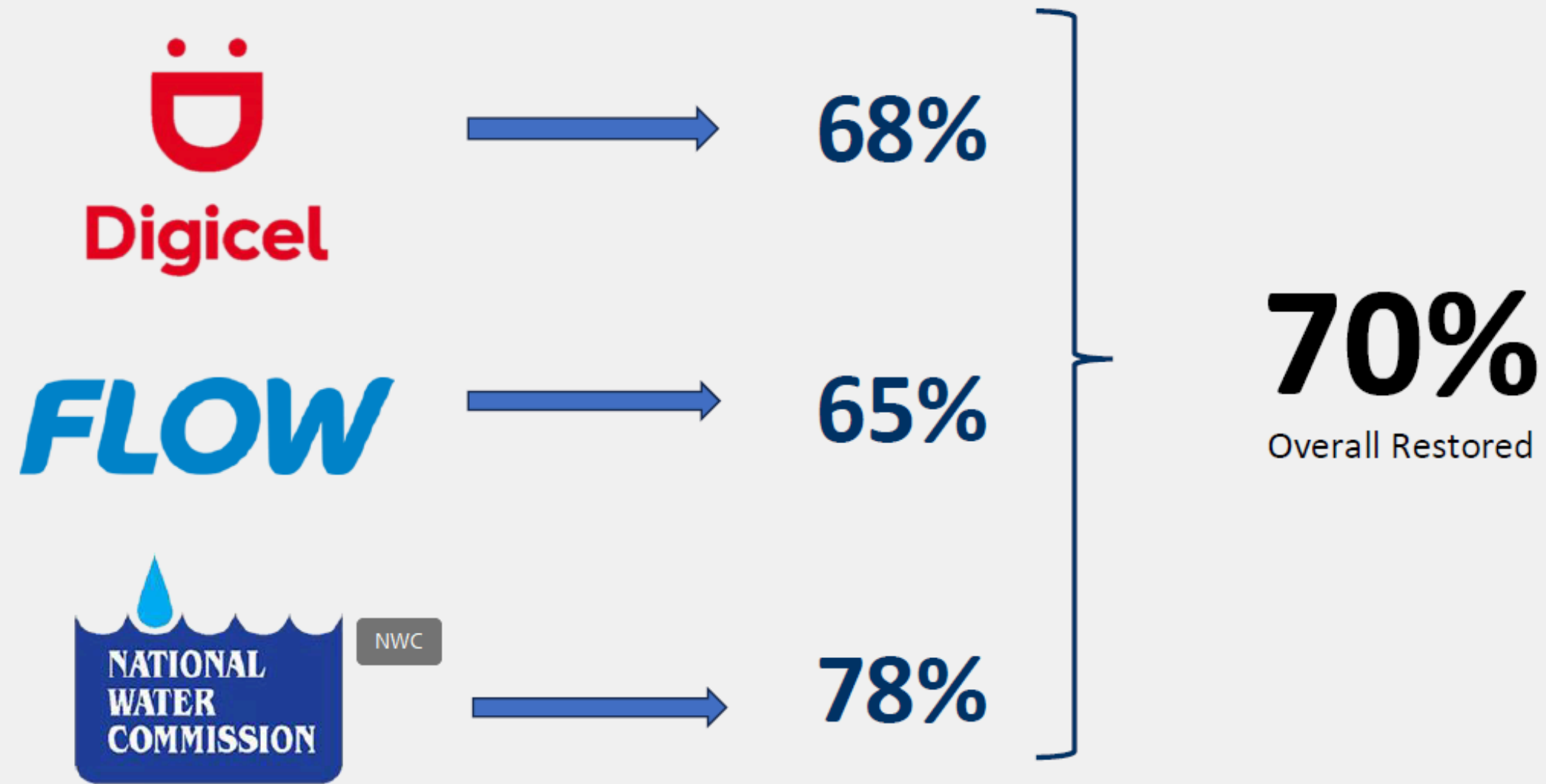

SYSTEM STATUS

% Critical Facilities Restored by Agency:



From the OUR's perspective, based on updates JPS has reported:

Restoration of critical facilities that depend on JPS power continues to advance.

- Digicel: JPS has reported 68 percent of its powered critical sites restored.
- FLOW: 65 percent restored.
- National Water Commission (NWC): 78 percent restored.

Overall, JPS has reported that 70 percent of all JPS-powered critical facilities have been restored islandwide.
